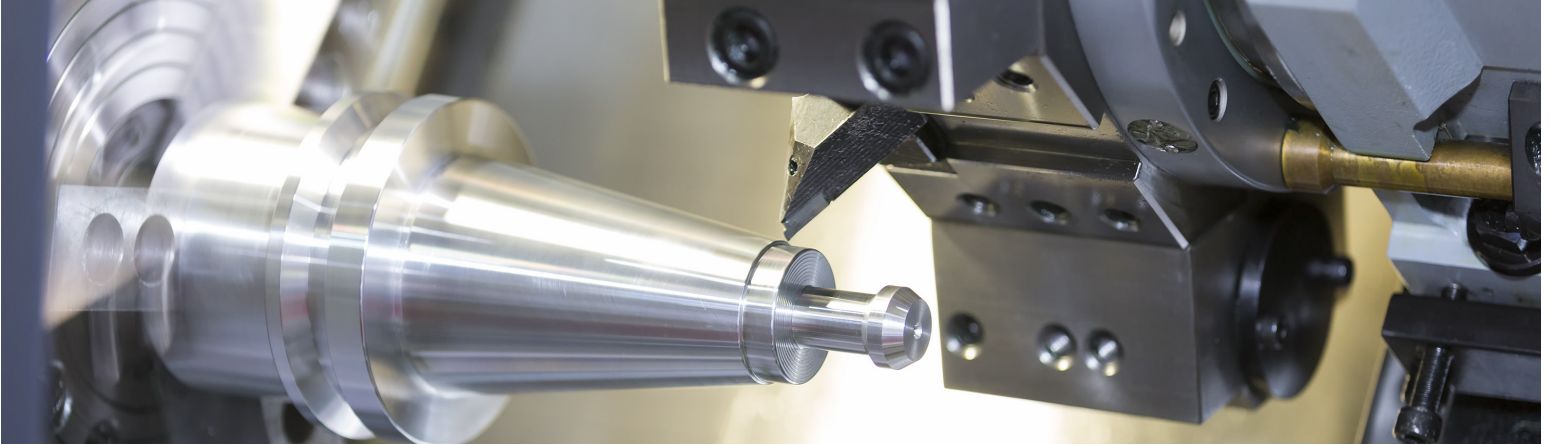


Tax Incentives For Manufacturing Companies



Write-Off \$1,080,000 in Equipment With Section 179 Tax Deduction*

Section 179 Federal Tax Deduction Increased to \$1,080,000

Section 179 Federal Tax Deduction: This deduction allows a company to deduct the first \$1,080,000 of equipment (Section 179 Property) acquired in 2022 from their taxable income. For companies acquiring up to \$2,700,000 of equipment, this deduction is available in full. It then phases out on a dollar-for-dollar basis for amounts over \$2,700,000. Financing or leasing with a \$1 buyout qualify.

100% Bonus Depreciation

In addition to the Section 179 Federal Tax Deduction, businesses can also take a 100% bonus depreciation on both new and used equipment after exceeding the \$1,080,000 write-off. Financing or leasing with a \$1 buyout qualify.

Standard Depreciation

In addition to the \$1,080,000 write-off and bonus depreciation, companies may be eligible to deduct federal depreciation on the adjusted basis of their qualified equipment, state depreciation, local tax incentives and interest expenses. Financing or leasing with a \$1 buyout qualify.
